Today marks the end of the official search for missing Malaysian Airlines Flight MH370. The GeoResonance team feels enraged that it has taken the ATSB-led team 1,046 days to acknowledge the “highly probable” MH370 search area in the southern Indian Ocean did not contain the plane.

It is no surprise to the scientific community that the search was a failure. This failure is an ultimate testament to a string of politically motivated decisions and the arrogant exclusion of different opinions.
